### Some Important Reminders:

- School Day: School starts at 8.55am (this is when the first bell goes). Morning Tea: 11.00 - 11.20am Lunch Time: 12.30 - 1.30pm School finishes at 3.00pm
- Absences: if your child is going to be absent or late please ring the office before 9am or leave a message on the answerphone. You can also send the office an email at <u>office@stbrigidsdn.school.nz</u>
- Morning Drop Off: children are able to arrive at school from 8.15am, the hall will be open at this time, and classrooms will open at 8.30am as normal. You are more than welcome to walk your child up the driveway in the mornings.



### Spiritual Reading

This term's spiritual reading is taken from Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter *Patris Corde* - With a Father's Heart. Marking the 150th anniversary of St. Joseph being declared patron of the universal church, Pope Francis proclaimed a year-long celebration dedicated to the foster father of Jesus. The pope said Christians can discover in St. Joseph, who often goes unnoticed, *"an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble...St. Joseph reminds us that those who appear hidden or in the shadows can play an incomparable role in the history of salvation.
