Headlice: are once again doing the rounds. Please be vigilant about checking children's hair regularly and following up with treatment if necessary. Did you know...From 1 May, 2017, 4% dimethicone lotion can be prescribed fully subsidised (from your GP) for the treatment of head lice, which adds another treatment option to the currently subsidised 0.5% phenothrin shampoo. Lice are unlikely to develop resistance to dimethicone lotion as it is not an insecticide and instead kills lice by suffocation.

PARKING – some reminders for next term: recently the yellow no parking lines were changed on Bayfield Road. Please refrain from parking on the yellow lines as this is illegal and very dangerous. Also we have had a few complaints about cars parking across our neighbour's driveways, this is also illegal and we would appreciate your co-operation with not doing this as well.

I'm thankful for this holiday.

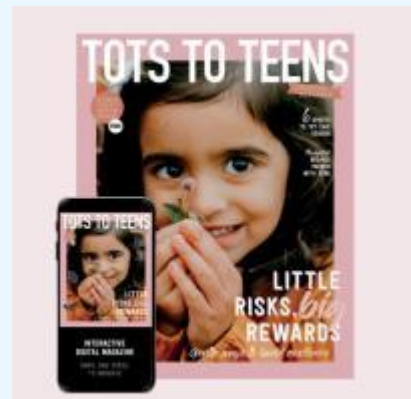
